

TABERNACLE PRAYER

1. The Outer Court: *Give God Thanks.*
 1. Thank Him for what you already have - gratitude
 2. Gratitude turns what you have into enough
 3. **Psalms 100:4, "Enter his gates with thanksgiving and courts with praise; give thanks to him and praise his name."**
2. The Brazen Altar: *Focus on the Cross.*
 1. Blood had to be spilled for the sins that were committed. In order for you to go to God, something had to die.
 2. Remember the cross. Picture what Jesus went through.
 3. **Romans 5:6, "When we were utterly helpless, Christ came at just the right time and died for us sinners."**
 4. On the cross there were four major wounds
 1. Whipped (transgressions)
 2. Crowned with thorns (peace)
 3. Spear in his heart (iniquities)
 4. Stripes on his back (healed)
 1. **Isaiah 53:5, "But he was pierced for our transgressions, he was crushed for our iniquities; the punishment that brought us peace was on him, and by his wounds we are healed."**
3. The Laver (There were mirrors in the bottom of the bowl so you would have to see yourself): *Offer every part of my life to God.*
 1. Put a gate in front of my eyes
 2. Let my ears be sensitive
 3. My mouth - be good at communication (anything you are good at the devil will try to pervert)
 4. etc.
 5. **Romans 12:1, "Therefore, I urge you, brothers, in view of God's mercy to offer your bodies as living sacrifices, a holy and pleasing to God - this I your spiritual at of worship."**
4. The Candlestick (7 prong Jewish candle- represents: Holy Spirit): *Invite the work of the Holy Spirit in my life.*
 1. Holy Spirit teach me how to lead my company
 2. We want the work of God on the inside of me.
 3. **2 Timothy 1:6-7, "This is why I remind you to fan into flames the spiritual gift God gave you awhen I laid my hands on you. For God has not given us a spirit of fear and timidity, but of power, love and self discipline."**
5. The Table of Showbread: *Claim the promises in God's Word.*

1. Matthew 4:4, "Jesus answered, It is written: 'Man shall not live on bread alone, but on every word that comes from the mouth of God.'"
6. The Altar of Incense (coals from outside altar making it burn): *Worship His Name.*
 1. When you praise God, you praise him for what He did.
 2. When you worship God, you worship Him for Who He is.
 3. It's all about your worth Lord - worthy
 1. Psalms 95:6-7, "Come, let us bow down in worship, let us kneel before the Lord our Maker; for he is our God and we are the people of his pasture, the flock under his care."
 4. A persons worth is found in their name
 5. Proverbs 18:10, "The name of the Lord is a strong tower; the righteous run to it and are safe."
 1. List the names of the Lord.
7. The Ark: *Intercede for others.*
 1. Make your case to God on behalf of someone else.
 2. 1 Timothy 2:1-2, "I urge, then, first of all, that petitions, prayers, intercession and thanksgiving be made for all people - for kings and all those in authority, that we may live peaceful and quiet lives in all godliness and holiness."
